### THE DUKE

**Pendleton rye whiskey, sweet vermouth, dash of walnut bitters, luxardo cherry | \$15**

John Wayne's career spanned more than 50 years, during which time he became something more than just an actor – he became a legend. And the story goes that The Duke enjoyed a whiskey from time to time at this very bar while filming scenes for some of his westerns out by the lake. His likeness at the entrance serves as a message of welcome to everyone who enters Cattlemen's Lounge.

### 1889

**Muddled mint, cucumber infused vodka, lime juice, club soda, sweet & sour | \$13**

In 1889, the same year that Paso Robles incorporated as a city, construction began on a magnificent new hotel. The new El Paso de Robles Hotel opened for business in 1891. The renamed Paso Robles Inn remains in the heart of downtown Paso.

### THE DIRTY JAMES

**Chopin vodka, Re:Find gin, olive juice | \$15**

Two infamous outlaws, Frank and Jesse James, were busy robbing trains and getting themselves on the "Most Wanted" list. In the spring of 1868, the duo headed to Paso Robles where they sought refuge with their uncle, Drury James. The hot springs helped Jesse heal from his gunshot wounds.

### THE CLARABELLE

**Absolut vanilla vodka, Godiva white chocolate liqueur, frangelico | \$15**

Residing in front of the Paso Robles Inn, Clarabelle the Wine Cow is one of 101 cows throughout San Luis Obispo County and was inspired by the beautiful wineries and vineyards that surround the area. Clarabelle loves to graze in the lush rolling hills of Paso Robles and snack on the delicious grapes grown right in her backyard.

### THE PADEREWSKI

**Redbreast whiskey and simple syrup shaken and poured over muddled mint, orange, and crushed ice | \$14**

In 1913, the world's most well-known concert pianist and composer, Ignace Paderewski, visited the hotel to soak in the mineral hot springs to heal his arthritis. After witnessing the healing powers of the hot springs, Paderewski returned to the hotel many times over the next 30 years. Today, the Paso Robles Inn is proud to showcase one of his pianos which sits in the entry to the ballroom.

### THE BURNING EMBER

**Bulleit rye whiskey over ice with muddled cherry, dash of bitters, simple syrup | \$14**

Paso Robles Hot Springs Hotel's golden era ended abruptly due to a massive fire on a cold December night in 1940. Realizing that the central part of the hotel was doomed, firefighters concentrated their efforts on saving the gracious dining room wing of the hotel – now what we call the ballroom – and the only part of the hotel that survived the fire.

### MARILYN'S KISS

**Hendrick's gin, lemon, simple syrup, topped with prosecco | \$15**

After a quick wedding in San Francisco, Marilyn Monroe and Joe DiMaggio headed down to Paso Robles where they spent their first night as man and wife enjoying a quiet dinner here at the Paso Robles Inn.

### SWEET HELEN

**Belvedere vodka, orange juice, peach schnapps, chambord and club soda over muddled raspberries | \$15**

Helen Sawyer was the daughter of the Hotel General Manager Frank Sawyer in 1912. No one knows for sure what happened to her, but she apparently decided to spend her afterlife playing where she lived as a child. There are many stories of her being "seen" near the ballroom.

### THE PIONEER

**Patron anejo, grand marnier, orange juice, Campari, lime juice, splash of Sprite | \$15**

El Paso de Robles, was originally part of a 25,000 acre Mexican land grant that was purchased by James and Daniel Blackburn in 1857. The land was a rest stop for travelers of the Camino Real Trail and was known for its mineral hot springs.
